The Institute was established in 1985 to address the technological training needs of production units within the National Fertilizer Corporation of Pakistan. Subsequently, in 1994, the institute diversified its activities by introducing a BSc Engineering Program in Chemical Engineering.

Upgradation of the Institute

In recognition of high quality standards of education maintained by the Institute, the Government of Pakistan up-graded the Institute to the status of Federally Charted Degree Awarding Institute in 2012 through NFC-IET Multan Act, 2012 duly passed by National Assembly and Joint Session of the Parliament on April 05, 2012.

<u>Unique Feature of Financial</u> <u>Self-Sustainability</u>




PHASE WISE DEVELOPMENT PLAN

New Arrangement for Payment of University Fee & Dues

There were many complaints of students/parents regarding long ques at HBL Fee Collection Booth established within the premises of the Institute. Consequently, on the directions of the Worthy Vice Chancellor to address these complaints, the Treasurer approached the United Bank Limited and finalized the proposal of Fee Collection with the approval of Finance & Planning Committee and the Syndicate. According to new mechanism of fee collection, the students can deposit their fee at any of the 1400 branches of United Bank Limited all over the country without any charges besides already available system of HBL Fee Collection Booth. Furthermore, for the facilitation of the students process of payment of fee through UBL Digital App is under process. These steps will surely save the precious time of the students which they could utilize to focus on their studies.

Increase in the Payment of Merit and Needy Scholarship

The Worthy Vice Chancellor directed the Finance Department to increase the rate of Merit & Needy Scholarships upto Rs.10,000/- per student (awardee) per year w.e.f. 2024-25.





BENEFITS FOR FACULTY & STAFF

Human Resources (Faculty/Staff) is considered as backbone of any organization and the management of the Institute is well aware of this reality. The worthy Vice Chancellor is committed for the betterment of Faculty and staff. In this regard following measures have been taken,

- 1- Rs. 1,000/- each cash award will be granted to all staff of cleanliness section (sweepers) and horticulture section (mali/baildars) for their dedicated work during Sports Week 2023.
- 2- In order to retain the experienced faculty members, the Rationalization Committee comprising of the Controller of Examinations, The Treasurer, The Registrar under the chair of Worthy Vice Chancellor has devised a comprehensive proposal to increase the salaries of the faculty members (Lab. Engineers, Lecturers & Assistant Professor) w.e.f 01-01-2024
- 3- The contract and daily wages staff will also be paid the increase in salaries @ 5 % w.e.f 01-01-2024
- 2- The management on the directions of the Worthy Vice Chancellor positively considering to increase the salaries of regular faculty and staff both on NFC grades and BPS @ 35 % for BPS 1-16, and 30 % for BPS 17 and above as allowed by the Federal Finance Division w.e.f 01-07-2023. The increase will be paid in three phases after availability of

funds and approval from the Finance & Planning Committee and the Syndicate. The sequence of disbursement of the increase will be as follows:

- Regular Employees on BPS Scales will be paid the increase w.e.f 01-07-2023 in 1st week of February 2024.
- Regular Employees on NFC Grades (S-I to G-II) will be paid the increase w.e.f 01-07-2023 in 1st week of April 2024.
- Regular Employees on NFC Grades (G-III and above) will be paid the increase w.e.f 01-07-2023 in 1st week of May 2024.

Scholarship for Children of NFC-IET Employees

The Children of NFC-IET Employees studying in Degree Programs are being paid Scholarship (educational stipend). Last time the rate was increased in 1994. The Worthy Vice Chancellor on the recommendations of the Scholarship Committee accorded approval to increase the Scholarship rates as follows:

Day Scholars:Rs.09,000/- p.a. to Rs.24,000/- p.a.Border:Rs.12,000/- p.a. to Rs.30,000/- p.a.
